April Outing - Draycote Reservoir

Saturday 17th April 2010

Meeting at the Visitor Centre Car Park at 0900, Draycote Reservoir is a large expanse of water surrounded by a good variety of meadow and woodland habitat, providing excellent areas for birds. Passage migrants such as Wheatear, Water & Rock Pipits and Yellow Wagtails have all been recorded here as well as being an important Gull and wildfowl refuge. This outing will involve a considerable amount of walking as we will walk all the way round the reservoir.

Directions:

Take the A426 from Rugby to the village of Dunchurch continue heading roughly south on the A426 looking out for the entrance to the reservoir on the right after a few miles, turning right onto the lane down to the Draycote Reservoir Visitor Centre Car Park.
