February Outing - Ouse Washes

Saturday 16th February 2008

Meeting at the Ouse Washes Reserve car park at 0830 the target species for the day will be Bewick's and Whooper swans as well as good numbers of wintering wildfowl and waders.

The Ouse Washes is a stunning example of lowland wet grassland habitat, the largest in the UK. In winter, the reserve is used by tens of thousands of ducks as well as the largest concentration of Bewick's and whooper swans anywhere in the UK.

Directions:

From the south and east head to Ely, take the A142 to Chatteris and follow signs to Manea. Entering the village, turn right at the RSPB sign towards Welches Dam, continuing to the signposted car park.
