Meeting at the Potteric Carr Reserve car park at 0900 the target species for the day will be the reserves famous wintering population of up to six Bitterns. The reserve is holding a 'Bittern Spectacular' event over this weekend though sightings cannot be guaranteed!

POTTERIC CARR is one of over 80 reserves owned or leased by the Yorkshire Wildlife Trust. Its wide range of habitats from open water and marsh to woodland, covering an area of about 200 ha (500 acres), give it an interesting diversity of wildlife.
