Meeting at the Potteric Carr Reserve car park at 0900. Having visited here in the winter of 2008, we agreed that this would be worthy of a return visit in springtime to catch up with the arrival of Warblers, Hirundines and Waders at this impressive and expanding reserve.

POTTERIC CARR is one of over 80 reserves owned or leased by the Yorkshire Wildlife Trust. Its wide range of habitats from open water and marsh to woodland, covering an area of about 200 ha (500 acres), give it an interesting diversity of wildlife.
