Weeting Heath National Nature Reserve is one of the most important areas of heath in Breckland, its open grassland & stony heath providing ideal habitat for the reserves speciality, Stone Curlews. Meeting at the reserve car park at 0930, we will spend the morning at this reserve before moving on to Lakenheath Fen, home to Hobbies, Bitterns, Common Cranes, Bearded Tits & Golden Orioles.

**Directions:**

NWT Weeting Heath is just west of Brandon on the Norfolk/Suffolk border. Leave Brandon going north on the A1065 to Mundford. Cross the railway line on the outskirts of the town, then turn left to Weeting and Methwold. In the village of Weeting, turn left to Hockwold cum Wilton, the car park and visitor centre are signed 2.5km west of Weeting.
