October Outing - Leighton Moss

Saturday 11th October 2008

Meeting at the reserve car park at 0900. Target species will be Bittern, Water Rail and Merlin. The Arnside and Silverdale peninsula lies just south of the Lake District and is an area of outstanding natural beauty, famous for its scenic area of woodlands, marshes and views across the expanse of Morecambe Bay. At its heart lies Leighton Moss, an RSPB reserve of shallow meres, reedbeds and saltmarsh, famous for its rare, yet accessible, birds and other wildlife.

Directions:

Take J35 off the M6 (signposted Carnforth), then follow the A6 north (signposted to Milnthorpe). Brown Tourist signs direct you to the reserve off the A6 and take you through the villages of Yealand Redmayne and Yealand Storrs.
