October Outing - Gibraltar Point

Saturday 20th October 2012

Gibraltar Point National Nature Reserve covers three miles of coast from Skegness to The Wash. Habitats include sandy and muddy seashore, sand dunes, saltmarsh and freshwater marsh with ponds and lagoons. The reserve is recognised internationally for its important habitats and species. Meeting at the reserve car park at 0930 our focus will be on passage migrants.

From Boston take the A52 to Skegness, continue through the town until reaching the roundabout by the Clock Tower, go back on yourself taking the first left down Gibraltar Lane, carry on along the lane until reaching the main car park next to the Visitor Centre.
