September Outing - Willington Gravel Pits & Foremark Reservoir

Saturday 15th September 2012

Willington Gravel Pits is a former sand and gravel quarry, it provides a haven for wildlife in the Trent Valley. The flooded gravel pits form an important wetland habitat attracting many rare birds in addition to a variety of more common species. Meeting at the entrance to the reserve on Meadow Lane, Willington at 0930. We will also be visiting the nearby Foremark Reservoir, a 230 acre reservoir and nature reserve.

Directions:

From Willington take the B5008 towards Repton, on approaching the road bridge over the River Trent take the turning on the right that leads to a small parking area on Meadow Lane. Do not drive down the lane beyond this area, access to the reserve is by foot only.
